


PROCEDURE

Install

1	Move the Left Protection Rail into designated workstation.
2	Install the Mounting Bracket to the Protection Rail.
3	Loosely install the nut that attaches the Mounting Bracket to the Protection Rail.
4	Move the Left Protection Rail aside.
5	Move the Right Protection Rail into designated workstation.

6	Install the Mounting Bracket to the Protection Rail.
7	Loosely install the M10 nut that attaches the Mounting Bracket to the Protection Rail.
8	Move the Right Protection Rail aside.
9	Apply applicable protection to the two Front Fenders .

10	Warning: The Protection Rail is large and heavy. The aid of another person is necessary for the step that follows to make sure that the Fender is not damaged. If you do not, this can cause serious injury and/or damage to the vehicle and equipment.
	Move the Left Protection Rail into position.
11	Move the Mud Flap aside.
12	Loosely install the two M10x20 bolts that attach the Mounting Bracket to the Rock Slider.
13	Move the Outer Clamp into position.



18	Use a Crows Foot to torque the M10 nut that attaches the Mounting Bracket to the Protection Rail to 35 Nm.
19	Move the Mud Flap back to its initial position.
20	Move the Right Protection Rail into position.
21	Move the Mud Flap aside.
